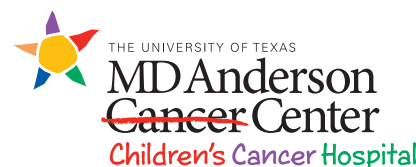

My brother, James, had a great attitude when it came to facing challenges and finding ways to overcome them, so we know that he is particularly excited this year. We are seeing a drug, whose initial research at M. D. Anderson TOKC helped to fund back in 2010, reach a Phase II Trial at M.D. Anderson, to which we have pledged \$1 million. Think about it - Because we have continued to move forward and focus on the work still to be done, the results of a research project you helped to fund are being used now to treat children with metastatic osteosarcoma, the same disease that took James' life.

Also, when James was about 17, he was one of the patients in an experimental drug trial that modified his own cells to help fight his cancer. Although the trial failed for James, thanks to the commitment of researchers to get this project "out of the trees", and your continued commitment to supporting pediatric cancer research, doctors at Texas Children's Hospital are making changes to that treatment to make it successful for all pediatric cancer patients.

Our work funding both of these research projects is bringing impactful, positive change in the world of pediatric cancer. As always, each of our research projects at M. D. Anderson and Texas Children's are being matched by those institutions, respectively, so the research can be guaranteed completion.

But all of this is about more than just research for kids with cancer. As James fully appreciated, kids with cancer need a reason to smile today. Not only are TOKC's #DoThatOneThing Councils continuing to grow (it is now present in 12 schools in the Coastal Bend and Kingsville area has resulted in over 800 volunteers), but it is also doing more. For example, each month adult volunteers go to the Ronald McDonald House to cook dinner for the families staying there, while #DoThatOneThing Council students spend the afternoon making crafts and playing games with the children, as well as spreading awareness for pediatric cancer in their own schools and communities. This is in addition to all of the other outreach programs we have to bring joy to the daily lives of kids with cancer, including monthly scheduled activities for patients and their families at Driscoll Children's, M.D. Anderson, Texas Children's and Ochsner Hospital For Children led by volunteers.

So please come join us for the 12th Annual James A. Ragan Triumph Scramble. We will have the Scheffler family back with us, and Scottie for the honorary start. He has already had great success on the Web.com Tour (multiple top 10 finishes), and we are grateful he still makes time for TOKC in support of kids with cancer. We will have our 2019 James' Wingman, as well as our longtime friends Andy Sacks, Thomas Morstead and the entire TOKC family. So please come join us for this year's James A. Ragan Triumph Scramble. Help James' Wingman continue to swing hard to get pediatric cancer treatment out of the trees and into the fairway. 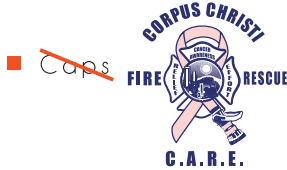
