

With your help, one of the research projects TOKC has funded has had excellent results and is moving into its next phase! This project at MD Anderson has identified an inhibitor of the molecule EZH2, called GSK126, that prevents the growth of osteosarcoma cells in the lungs - the same kind of cancer that took James' life.

This means that a target to prevent the growth and development of lung metastasis in patients with osteosarcoma has finally been identified. There are already FDA-approved chemotherapies to treat other types of cancer that use this inhibitor, so the next step will be working to start a clinical trial to provide more treatments in kids with osteosarcoma.
